



## Call2Come Statement of Faith

*"The Spirit and the Bride say, 'Come.' And let the one who hears say, 'Come.'"*  
(Revelation 22:17)

### **Preface: Our Evangelical Foundations**

Call2Come affirms the historic, biblical faith shared by evangelicals around the world. We gratefully acknowledge and affirm the Lausanne Covenant (1974) as a global expression of evangelical unity and commitment to world evangelization.

While standing in full agreement with its core declarations—particularly the authority of Scripture, the centrality of Christ, and the mission of the Church—we also believe the Holy Spirit is highlighting specific truths in our generation concerning the identity of the Church as the Bride of Christ and the urgency of His return. The following statement reflects our alignment with Lausanne, while expressing the unique calling entrusted to Call2Come.

### **1. The Scriptures**

We believe that the Bible, both Old and New Testaments, is the inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God. It is the supreme and final authority in all matters of faith and life. (2 Timothy 3:16–17; 2 Peter 1:20–21)

### **2. God the Trinity**

We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—co-equal and co-eternal—who created all things and governs all history according to His will. (Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:19)

### **3. Jesus Christ**

We believe in the deity, virgin birth, sinless life, atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension, and future return of Jesus Christ. He is the only Savior and the soon-

coming Bridegroom King. (John 1:1–14; Philippians 2:5–11; 1 Thessalonians 4:16–17)

#### **4. The Holy Spirit**

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, who glorifies Christ, convicts of sin, regenerates believers, and empowers the Church for mission. He also prepares the Bride in holiness and love. (John 16:13–14; Romans 8:9–17; Revelation 19:7–8)

#### **5. Salvation**

We believe that salvation is by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. All who repent, believe in Him, and are born again receive forgiveness, new life, and adoption as sons and daughters of God—and are called to live as part of the Bride. (Ephesians 2:8–9; John 3:3; Romans 8:14–17)

#### **6. The Church as the Bride**

We believe that the universal Church is the Body of Christ and also the Bride of Christ. As the Bride, she is being purified, matured, and awakened in intimacy and longing for the return of her Bridegroom. (Ephesians 5:25–27; 2 Corinthians 11:2; Revelation 22:17)

#### **7. The Return of Christ**

We believe in the imminent, personal, and glorious return of Jesus Christ. He will come again as Bridegroom, King, and Judge to receive His prepared Bride and to consummate His Kingdom on earth. (Revelation 22:12, 17, 20; Matthew 24:30–31)

#### **8. The Mission of the Church**

We believe that the Church is commissioned to proclaim the gospel, make disciples of all nations, and call all people into their bridal identity in Christ. Our mission is fueled by the urgency of His return and the cry, 'Come, Lord Jesus.' (Matthew 28:18–20; Revelation 22:17)

#### **9. Eternal Destiny**

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost—the saved unto eternal life in God's presence, and the lost unto eternal separation. We await the new heavens and new earth where righteousness dwells. (John 5:28–29; Revelation 21:1–4)

### **Closing Commitment**

We hold these truths in faith and love, as those who are not only saved and sanctified, but betrothed to Christ. As part of the global Body, we unite with all who love His appearing, and we respond to the Spirit's call to prepare the way for the Bridegroom.
